## INTRODUCTION

Budgets are crafted and approved for the objective of implementing policies and plans. Ultimately, the budget is meant to touch lives, improve livelihoods, promote a higher standard of living, grow the economy and enhance development. For this to happen, policy makers in the executive and legislature, citizens, businesses, households, communities and their organizations need to collaborate to prepare as well as to implement the budget. But the beginning point in implementation is citizen's access to information on what has been provided in the budget. Budget projects have designated beneficiaries and the proposed beneficiaries need to know the specific provisions and the qualifying criteria to become an actual beneficiary of public interventions.

This Pull Out is produced to provide information to Small Scale Women Farmers of Nigeria (SWOFON) of provisions in the 2024 Federal Budget containing projects which may be of interest and benefit to them. They include provisions from the parent Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security, its institutes and colleges; State House Headquarters; Federal Ministry of Labour and Employment; Secretary to the Government of the Federation. Others include Federal Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation; Federal Ministry of Education; Federal Ministry of Health and Social Welfare; Federal Ministry of Environment; Federal Ministry of Industry, Trade and Investment; Federal Ministry of Water Resources; Federal Ministry of Tourism; Federal Ministry of Budget and National Planning; Federal Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs and Poverty Alleviation; Federal Ministry of Youth Development, and Federal Ministry of Women Affairs.

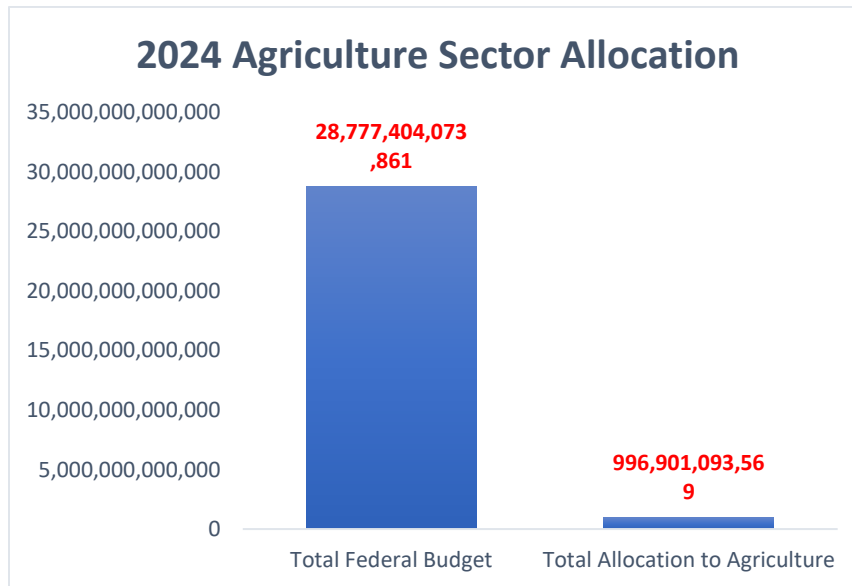
Key words used by the Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) in describing the projects include “empowerment”, “strategic training”, “training” and “capacity building”. Others are “provision”, “supply”, and “sensitization”, etc. This Pull Out therefore serves a couple of purposes. Beyond providing information, it will assist women farmers to hold MDAs to account for the expenditure of state resources. It is also an empowering tool, an advocacy tool based on empirical evidence that tells women farmers of the possibility of engaging MDAs at the budget preparation stage so that their voices can be heard in specific projects that will improve their productivity. It is a call for the full release and implementation of appropriated projects and in subsequent years, increased budgetary allocations to activities specifically targeted at Small Scale Women Farmers.

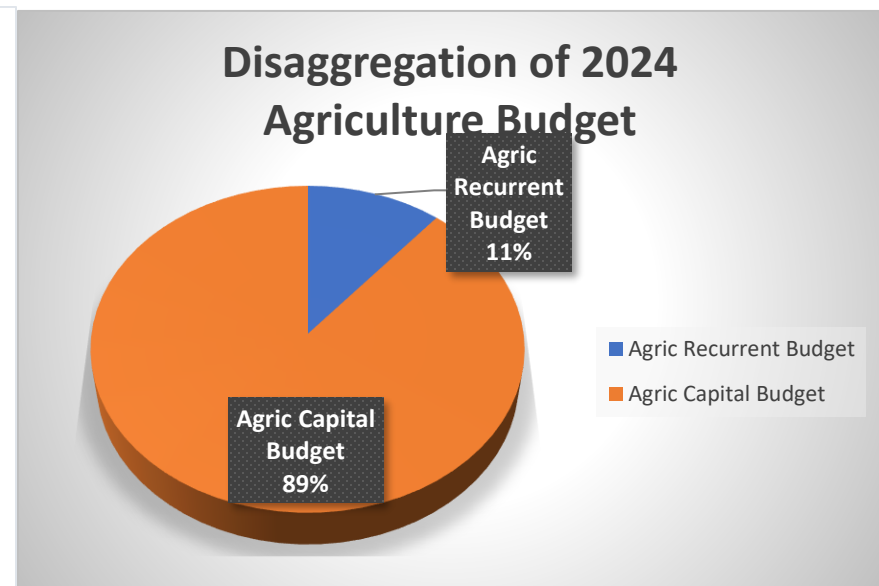

## WOMEN IN AGRICULTURE PROJECTS IN THE 2024 FEDERAL BUDGET

This section is the crux of this project, it captures selected projects that are of interest to smallholder women farmers (SWOFON). These projects will serve as focal points of SWOFON's engagement on the 2024 budget.

The Capital budget pullout for women in Agriculture, particularly for smallholder women farmers by design is intended to identify and collate capital projects in the federal budget that have potentials to impact their farming activities. It essentially captures projects which the women may have interest in and possibly benefit from. It also features some projects whose impact on the activities of the women farmers may be indirect. While majority of the projects are domiciled in core Agriculture MDAs, it also considered projects outside the sector for similar reasons.

The Federal government allocated only 3.46% of its 2024 budget to the Agriculture sector. This pull-out from the federal 2024 budget is drawn from several MDAs within and outside the core Agriculture sector.

### **SUMMARY OF FINDINGS FROM PULLOUT**

- 3.46 percent of the entire 2024 federal budget was allocated to the agricultural sector in the sum of **N996,901,093,569.00**.
- 89% of the Agric budget (**N886,652,814,701**) is allocated to capital expenditure (projects) while **N110,248,278,868** representing 11% is for recurrent expenditure.

- Out of the sector's total capital allocation, only **N33,942,431,210** representing **4%** are projects where women are specifically mentioned. Even at this, over 90% of these are constituency projects, and almost all of these are merged with youth in the project description.
- The description of several of these projects are unclear and lack specificity in terms of activities and deliverables. Most of them are without specific locations including for projects tagged as 'ongoing'. This makes it difficult for effective tracking and monitoring of such projects.
- Most of the projects that specifically target women are constituency projects for various legislative constituencies across the country. Most of these constituency projects are empowerment and capacity building projects.
- There are several engagement opportunities beyond the 5 IBP focal states. SWOFON members from other states can leverage information contained in this pull-out for engagement across states and regions.
- Engagement on these projects falls under one of the following target areas of the IBP SPARK II project;
  - Government prioritizes timely release of funds for critical agricultural inputs and gender friendly equipment for smallholder women farmers (*Campaign actions and strategic engagements for systems change*). – Result Area 2
  - Increased participation of SWOFON/ Agency groups in Agricultural budget decision making, implementation and oversight processes (*Strategic engagements to shift PFM system*). – Result Area 3

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- ✓ SWOFON should target influencing significant increase in the allocation to agriculture and also increasing the sector's allocation to women-specific projects, including the possibility of separating women from youth projects.
- ✓ Given that huge quantum of constituency funds is budgeted in the Agric sector, SWOFON members across the 36 states and the FCT should leverage opportunities provided through constituency projects to engage their representatives in the Senate and House of Representatives for inclusion as captured in the SWOFON Charter of Demand across all their locations.
- ✓ SWOFON should advocate for specificity of projects and their locations being included in the budget.
- ✓ SWOFON members across the different locations should leverage every available opportunity for cross-learning and experience sharing on outcomes of their tracking and monitoring exercise.
